1.2 OUR HISTORY

Central Cape Repairs is based in Weipa, near Tjungundji country, and established by Traditional Owner, Craig Savo, the Company's Director. It's 100% indigenous owned, and has been in operations since 2015. Central Cape Repairs (CCR) are **Trucking Specialists**, so we primarily provide Trucks, Haulage equipment and services for mining and civil projects in the Cape York region, Far North Queensland.

Ongoing Road Construction projects on the **Peninsula Development Road (PDR)** in Cape York, allowed the Company's Director, Craig, to see an opportunity to use his 30-year Heavy Machinery Diesel Mechanic background, to carefully select and maintain market-leading trucks, Kenworth T904 and T650 to haul road base materials, transport water for road construction, and to float road construction machinery to site projects. Clients such as *Northern Haulage & Diesel Services, Rio Tinto* and *Bama Services* have relied on and continue to rely on the services CCR provide, to support their PDR Projects.

We support Land Regeneration and Rehabilitation also and now **supply Native Seed** from the Weipa region to *Metro Mining*.

Having established partnerships with local mining industries, *local Councils* in the Cape York region, CCR are well placed in securing future contract opportunities.

The Director, Craig, an experienced truck driver himself, has extensive local knowledge of the Cape and it's communities, meaning Clients will receive personal and quality service. Clients have the assurance that their projects will be completed professionally, with equipment that are safe, well-maintained, and reliable.

Central Cape Repairs are trucking experts whereby they would use CCR equipment for Rio Tinto projects on the PDR. Bama Services in recent times have utilized CCR equipment for their road construction projects on the PDR also.

*** 2.2 OUR SERVICES**

Central Cape Repairs services include Truck hire, Labour hire and recently, supply Native Seed to support Land regeneration for mine sites.

Truck Hire: Central Cape Repairs use Kenworth equipment, T904, T609 and T650 trucks. Other CCR equipment includes Trailers AB Triple Side Tippers, Quad Axle float and a Flat top. All of these are utilised for road construction on the Peninsula Development Road (PDR). Works to date consist of Gravel haulage and a Water truck for road construction on the PDR. Individual requests from local businesses for Float work of heavy machinery around the Weipa area occur from time to time, but the focus has been road construction. Then, to meet the ongoing works to seal the PDR between Laura and Weipa, CCR have expanded their team so have experienced Drivers, with the current team having at least 30 years of civil and earthworks knowledge and experience. Drivers are available on Labour Hire also.

Native Seed Collection: Central Cape Repairs liaise with a Seeds Expert to carefully collect native canopy seeds for Land regeneration and in line with government regulations. Seasonal native seeds are collected at various times throughout the year, around areas close to Weipa.



2.3 PREFERRED BUSINESS







Central Cape Repairs prefer Civil Work projects where Gravel haulage, Water trucks or Float work are needed.

Projects to date have revolved around work on the Peninsula Development Road in Cape York, so CCR's experience and expertise relate to this type of work. CCR was a preferred supplier for Northern Haulage and Diesel Services who regularly supplied CCR equipment to Rio Tinto for 7 years. Each Kenworth is personally serviced and maintained by Craig, who is a fully qualified Heavy Equipment Mechanic. Although Kenworth has its own recommended maintenance schedule, Craig's schedule OEM exceeds specifications. This adds to his personal guarantee of wanting to provide quality and reliable equipment for your project. Should a breakdown occur, Craig will be able to assist here too.

Although Kenworth trucks provide a OEM maintenance schedule, Craig's maintenance schedule exceeds OEM specifications. Weekly maintenance checks are conducted. Service intervals are



shorter. Why do this? Craig only uses equipment that are to a high standand to ensure reliability, reduce downtime and to provide a high quality delivery of service. New equipment, such as the Trailers AB Triple Side Tipper, were acquired for both recent and upcoming projects.



2.7 CAPACITY LEVELS

Central Cape Repairs have a team ready for Labour hire or Truck hire or native Seed collecting, and have established working relationships with local businesses, to source other equipment or



labour when Projects require it. CCR can source equipment such as 140H & 160H Graders with Final trim grader Operator, Side Tippers, Water Carts. Labour is easily sourced from local Employment Agencies also, but Craig's local knowledge of skill availability can help if more resources are required.
